Business & Correspondence:

1. Policing Cost Relief – Director Towndale: explained that the Government of Ontario made a recent announcement of more than \$77 million in funding to assist small and rural municipalities in managing the increasing costs associated with Ontario Provincial Police (O.P.P.) services. Cornwall, which operates its own municipal police service, are excluded. We are also facing increased costs to meet the increasingly complex demands of providing adequate and effective policing services under the *Community Safety and Policing Act* (CSPA). Mayor Towndale and Council will be drafting a letter to the Solicitor General requesting fair and equitable treatment needed to strengthen policing services in Cornwall.
